GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR NCBW-LAC SCHOLARSHIP

Students must apply for the NCBW-LAC scholarship during their senior year in high school, their first through fourth year of college or as a graduate student.

To be considered for an NCBW-LAC Scholarship, a student must:

Apply for the NCBW-LAC Scholarship by completing the scholarship application (including essay question), applicable scholarship year.

Demonstrate leadership through academic achievements and campus/community activities.

Have an overall grade point average of 2.5 or higher.

Be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program for the fall semester of the applicable scholarship year.

Mail or email your school transcripts to NCBW-LAC Scholarship Committee's attention, 19702 Enslow Drive, Carson, CA 90746 or bdodd423@pacbell.net. (310) 413-0664.

Complete the required two essays (minimum 100 words), topics:

- 1. How did you cope with the Pandemic?
- 2. Current Event: What do you consider to be the most pressing global issue today and why? Racism, Global Warming, World Hunger etc.
- 3. Give an example where you took a leadership role how you handle it and what were the results?

Adhere to the deadline of September 25th of each applicable scholarship year.

Files will have to be prepared prior to starting Online Application and will have to be in PDF format for uploading.

If awarded a scholarship, you will be willing to volunteer in the Los Angeles Chapter's College for Teens Program, or any other area of interest in the Chapter, when available.

All awardees must provide proof of enrollment (e.g. college, vocational, or technical school acceptance letter) into an institution of study.

A virtual interview will be required..
